DISCLAIMER

This document provides an overview of EU harmonisation legislation covered by [Regulation \(EU\) 2019/1020 on market surveillance and compliance of products \(O.J. L 169, 25.06.2019, p.1\)](#). It is a non-binding guidance document, which is only intended to facilitate the application of the Regulation. The European Commission and the EU Product Compliance Network do not accept any responsibility or liability regarding the information contained in this document. This information is not necessarily comprehensive, complete, accurate or up to date. Only the Official Journal of the European Union is authentic and produces legal effects.

Regulation (EU) 2019/1020 establishes three different scopes of application:

- 1) The Regulation applies to products that are subject to the EU harmonisation legislation listed in its Annex I, in so far as there are no specific provisions with the same objective in the harmonisation legislation (*lex specialis* principle). This Annex, as adopted by the legislators on 20 June 2019, contains 70 pieces of legislation.
- 2) Article 4 of the Regulation laying down the requirement of an economic operator established in the EU applies to a narrower set of EU harmonisation legislation, initially including 18 directives and regulations.
- 3) Chapter VII of the Regulation concerning products entering the EU applies to all products covered by EU law, in so far as there are no specific provisions relating to the organisation of controls on products entering the EU market (*lex specialis* principle).

On the date of adoption of Regulation (EU) 2019/1020, on 20 June 2020, the general scope (point 1) and the specific scope in relation to Article 4 (point 2) were those defined by the Regulation, respectively in Annex I and in Article 4(5). However, the legislators anticipated that this situation would not remain static and that new harmonisation legislation would be adopted in the future, to which Regulation (EU) 2019/1020 should also apply. Recital 6 clarified that “[...] if new Union harmonisation legislation is adopted in the future, it will be for that legislation to specify whether this Regulation is also to apply to that legislation”.

In other words, the lists of legislation laid down in Annex I and Article 4(5) were only a starting point. The scope of Regulation (EU) 2019/10 can and has already evolved via the adoption of specific provisions in sectoral legislation, without necessarily modifying Annex I and Article 4(5).

In order to facilitate the work of market surveillance authorities, this document reflects the current scope of Regulation 2019/1020. It is purely informal and does not have any legal value. However, it is intended to be a dynamic document informing EUPCN members of the evolution of the scope of the Regulation.

The document contains two lists:

- The list of EU harmonisation legislation to which Regulation (EU) 2019/1020 applies ([go to list](#)). It includes not only the pieces of legislation listed in Annex I (and where applicable their successors) but also the additional sectoral legislation specifying that Regulation 2019/1020 applies to it;
- The list of EU harmonisation legislation to which Article 4 of Regulation (EU) 2019/1020 applies ([go to list](#)). It includes not only the pieces of legislation listed in Article 4(5) but also the additional sectoral legislation specifying that Article 4 applies to it.
